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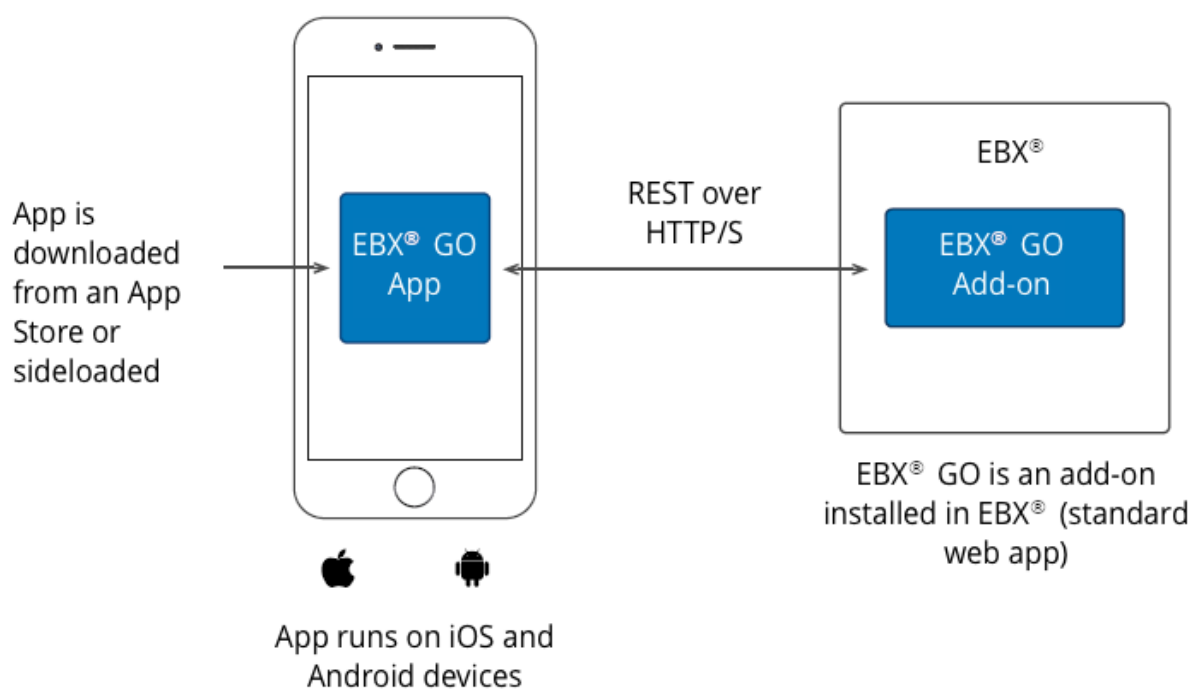
Overview

Designed to meet today's fast-paced, on-the-go business demands, the TIBCO EBX® GO Add-on allows users to search, filter, access and share data from anywhere on their mobile device. Additionally, users can accept and reject workflow items.

How does it work?

As illustrated below, the EBX GO Add-on is comprised of two main components:

- *The Add-on* — As the server side component, administrators must first install and configure the add-on in TIBCO EBX®. Easily implemented configuration options determine what data users can access and how it is viewed. See [Configuring the add-on](#) for more information.
- *The App* — The client side component (EBX GO Add-on for iOS and EBX GO Add-on for Android) is a native application that runs on iOS and Android devices. Business users download and install the app on their mobile device and connect to EBX® to access data.

TIBCO EBX® Digital Asset Manager Add-on integration

In the app users can view and download assets managed by the EBX® Digital Asset Manager Add-on. Assets can be accessed from a record's details view. Additionally, while in the app's tabular view, a thumbnail of image assets can be displayed for each record. For example, this could be a useful way to show a profile, or product picture for each record. To enable display of image thumbnails in the app:

1. The first field in the record must be the *mediaType* field containing the asset to display. Users can still view assets contained in other fields, but they won't display as the record's thumbnail.
2. The field can only contain one asset. If it contains multiple assets, users will have to open the record details to view the assets.

3. The app supports the following image types for thumbnail display: .png, .jpg, .jpeg, .bmp, and .gif.

Overview

You enable users to access data via the mobile app by using EBX® perspectives. Perspectives determine which data users can access and how menus display in the app. For information on creating a perspective, see the *Using the EBX® user interface* heading in the *EBX® User Guide*. 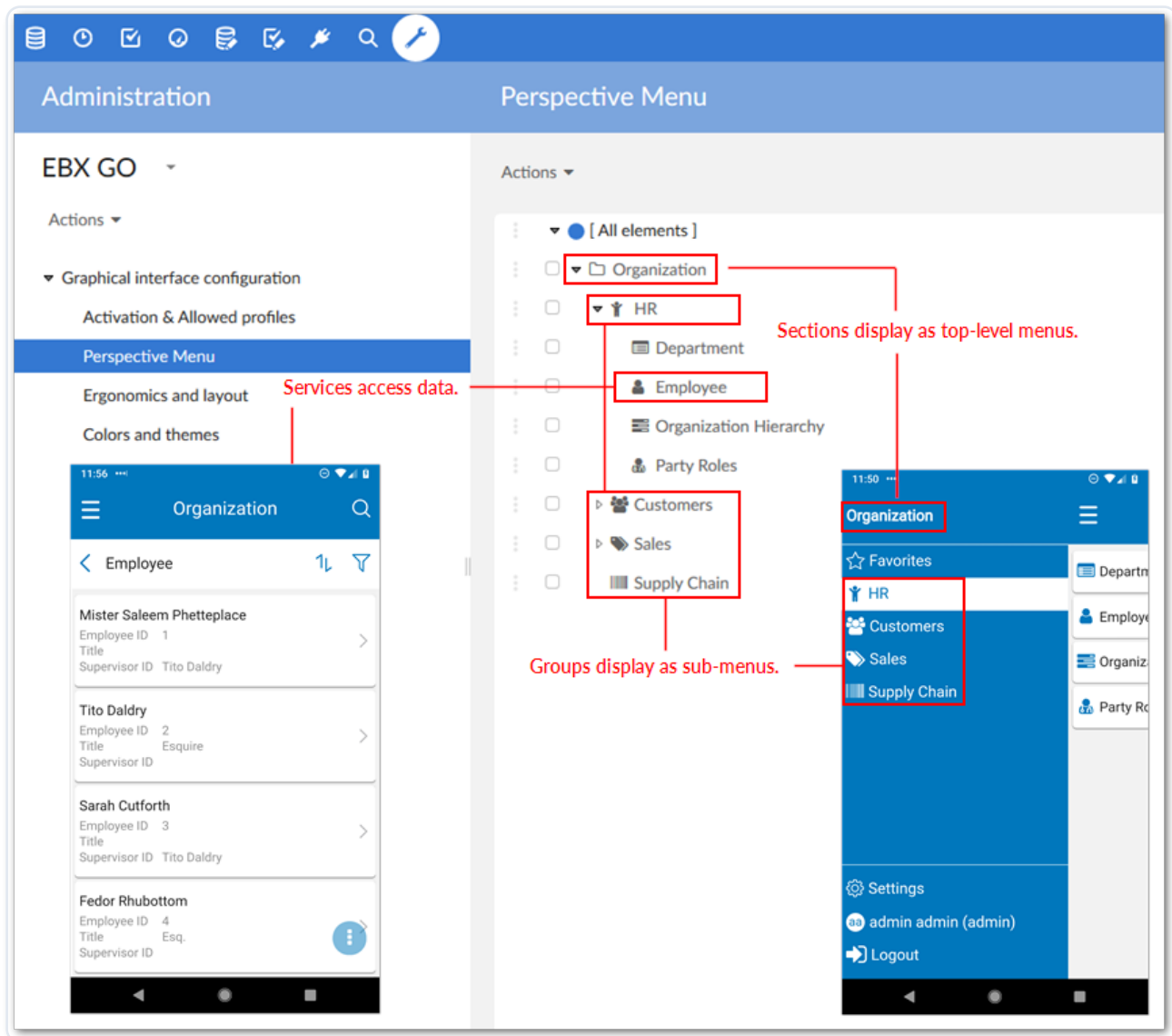
How perspective elements map to the app

The following illustrates how components of an EBX® perspective translate to the mobile app:

- Each **Section** in a perspective displays as a main domain or menu option. Each **Group** displays as a sub-menu option.
- **Services** provide access to data.

Note:

To display an association in the mobile app, you must publish the data model with the association's **Data services** field set to **Included in Data Services**.



Associating a perspective and profile

An association between perspective and profile allows users to access data included in the perspective. As described below, it is a straightforward process to associate profiles with perspectives:

1. Navigate to *Administration > User interface > User interface configuration > Advanced perspective*.
2. Open the perspective you want to make accessible via the app, or create a new perspective and select **Activation and Allowed profiles**.
3. Be sure the users to whom you want to grant access are included in the **Allowed profiles** list.
4. From the **Allowed devices** drop-down, select **EBX GO Add-on**. If this perspective is meant only to be accessed from the add-on, ensure **EBX® Web application** is not listed as an allowed device. Otherwise, the perspective is accessible from the mobile and web applications.

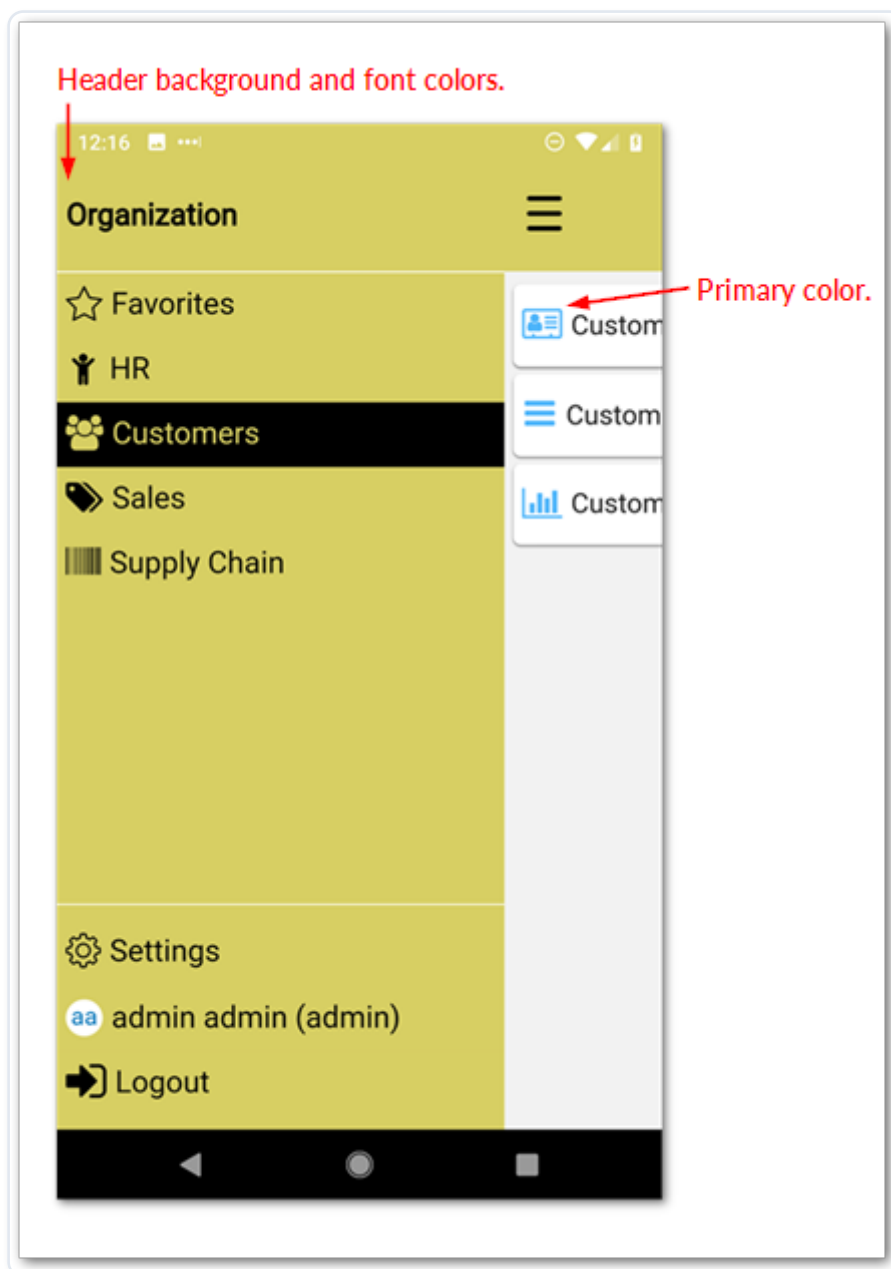
5. After saving and closing, users included in the perspective's allowed profiles can view the perspective from their EBX GO Add-on for iOS or EBX GO Add-on for Android mobile applications.

Setting app colors and themes

You can customize the colors and font displayed in the app to match your organization's branding. The display settings applied here override any existing perspective color settings when using the mobile app.

To change these settings:

1. Navigate to *Administration > TIBCO EBX® GO Add-on > Mobile interface configuration > Colors and themes*.
2. Update the desired settings. The following image outlines which areas of the app these settings apply to.

**Note:**

The **Secondary color** options applies to other icons like the **Favorites** icon.

Enabling offline data access

Overview

You can allow users to download and access data when their device is offline, or not connected to a network. Just as when a user's device is connected to a network, they access the data via EBX® perspectives.

When enabling offline data access, you indicate the available mobile-enabled data perspectives and add a list of users and roles allowed to download the data. Each perspective can have multiple profiles explicitly allowed or disallowed to download that perspective's data. These permission settings allow you give only certain users the ability to download data, while others can still access the data, but only while online.

Attention:

Users must use the **ENABLE CUSTOM AUTHENTICATION** option in the app to enable download of data.

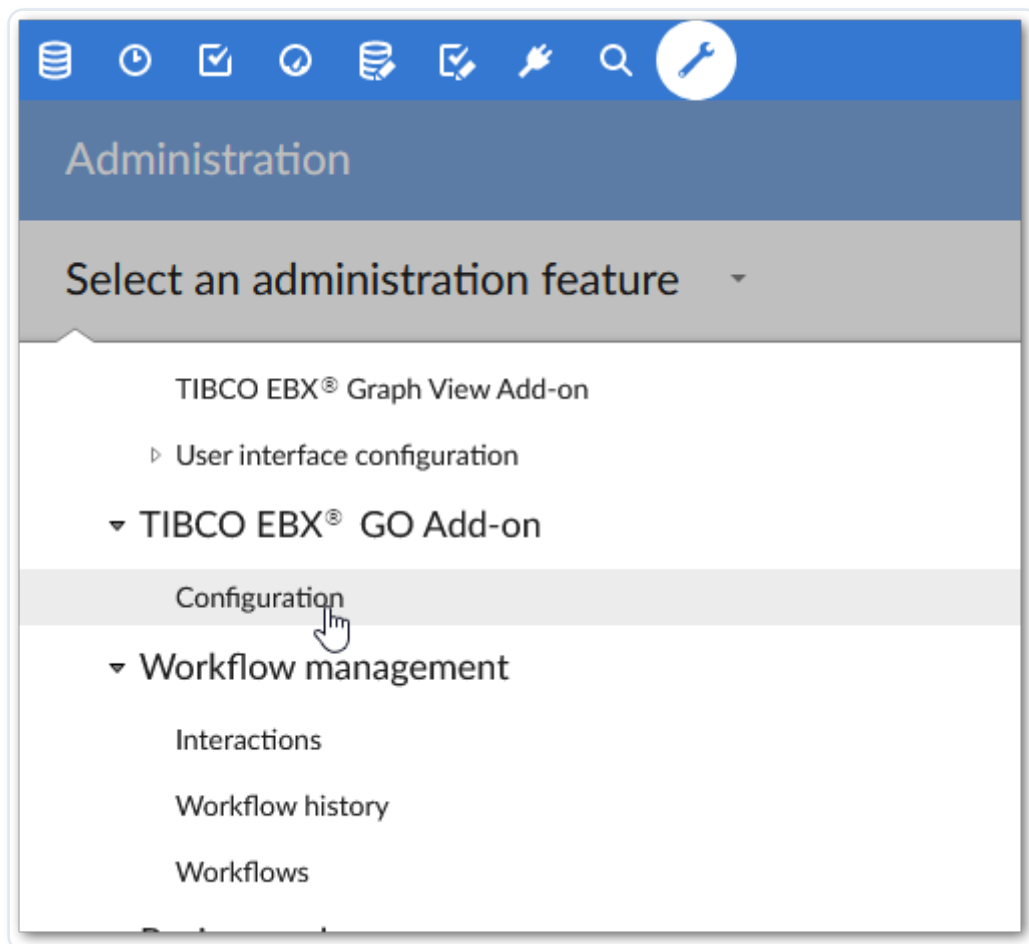
Features supported for offline data:

- Data is viewable using the default view only.
- Users can track and manage a list of their favorite offline records.
- Search is enabled.

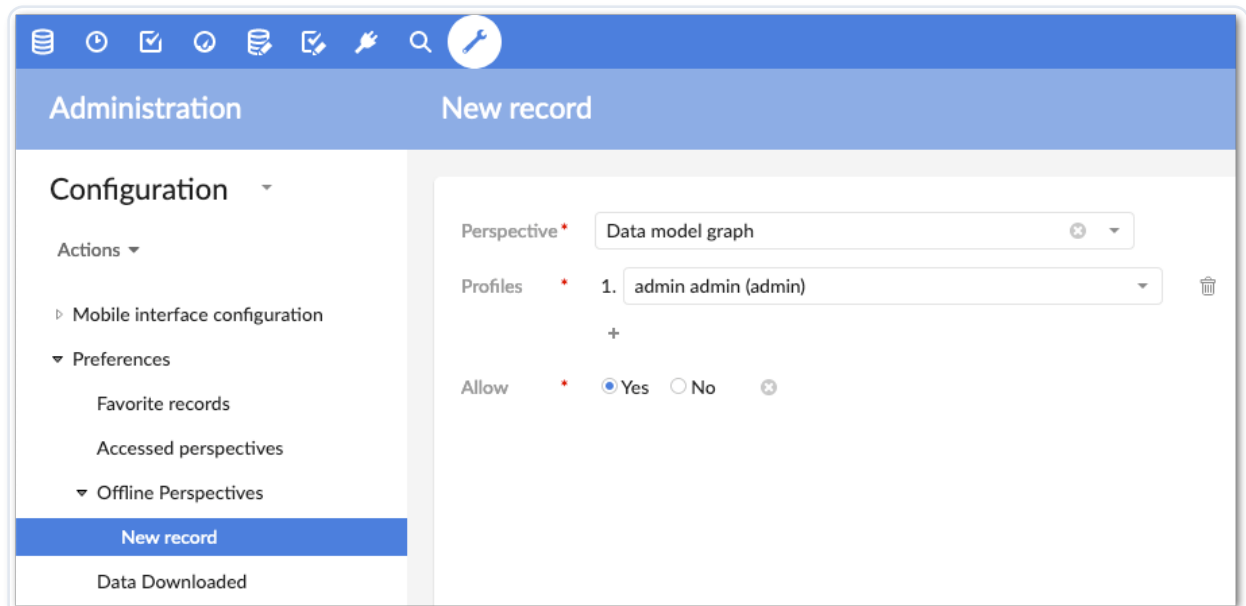
Making data available offline

To make a perspective's data available offline:

1. Access the add-on's configuration area by selecting the **Administration** option from the main menu bar and then *TIBCO EBX® GO Add-on > Configuration*.



2. Add a perspective to the **Offline Perspectives** table by creating a new record. This record also allows you to specify which profiles can download the perspective's data.



3. Save and close.

Tracking downloaded data

The add-on allows you to monitor downloaded data. To view this information, select the **Data Downloaded** table in the add-on's administration area. This table shows:

- Which data was downloaded.
- Who downloaded the data.
- When the download occurred.

Overview

You can configure the add-on to use a widget to display maps in the mobile app. When users select a record that includes a defined map location, an interactive map displays according to the configuration options you set.

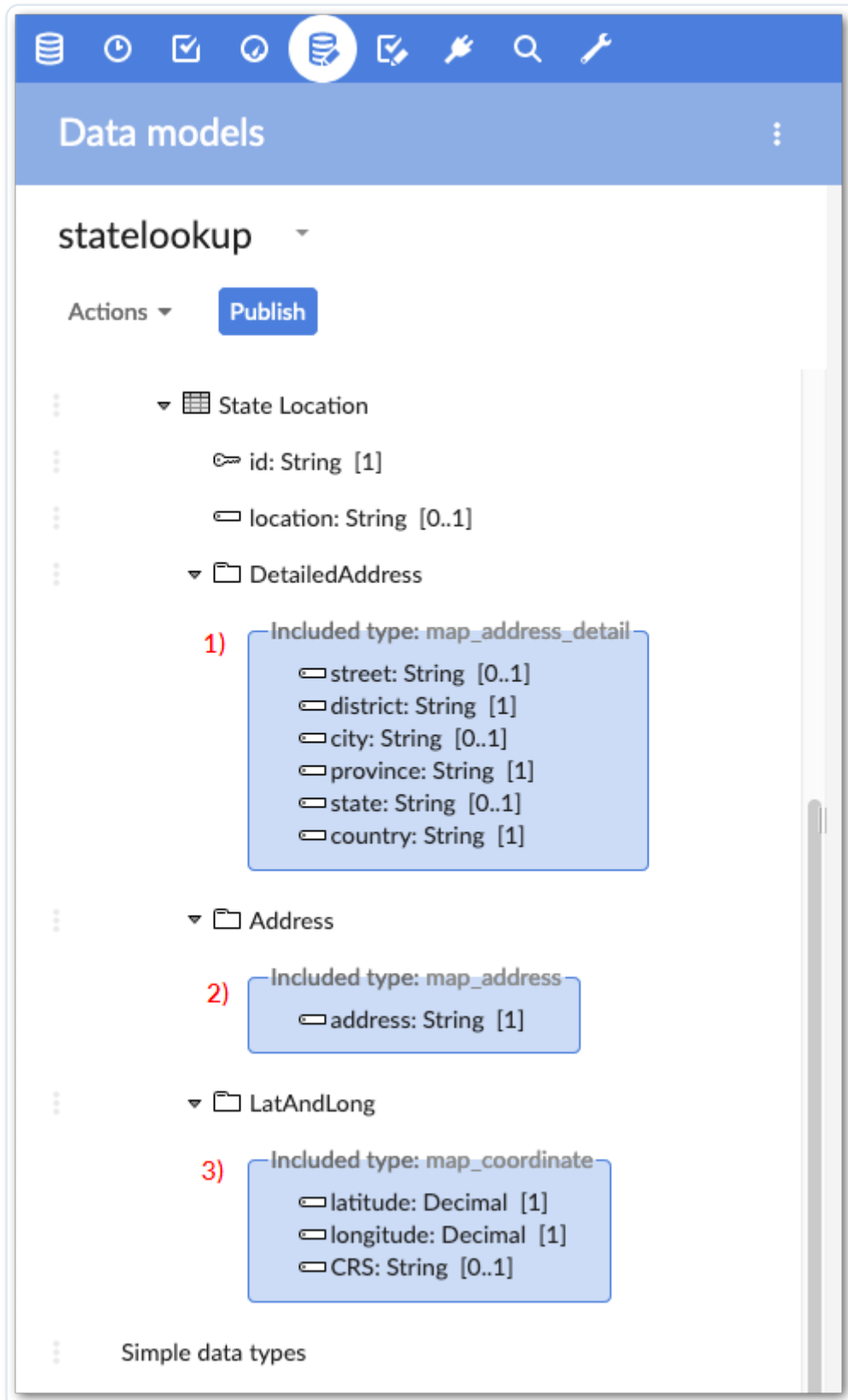
The add-on's configuration process for enabling map display involves the two main steps described below:

- Update a data model to include a special *map* data type field. See [Adding a map to a data model](#) for more instructions.
- In the add-on, create a map component widget and link it to the map type data model field. During this step you specify permissions, display options and any other required parameters. See [Configuring the map widget](#) for instructions.

Adding a map to a data model

A map widget must be linked to a data model field of type **map**. Since EBX® does not provide this type by default, you must add the **ebx-addon-common** module's `map-type.xsd` file to your model.

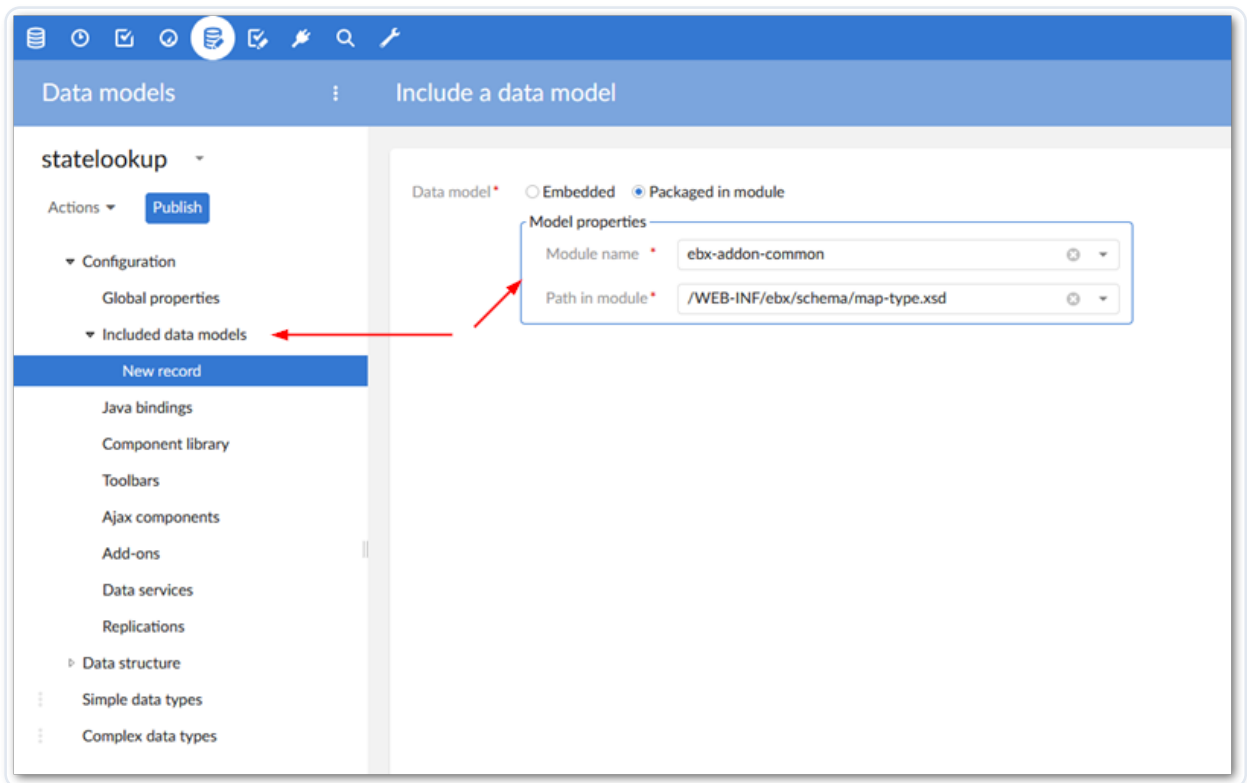
A map data type is an EBX® reusable type that, when used in your data model, adds a group and fields. You can choose a type from three options. Each variation accepts location data using a different format. This means that in order to display a map of a particular location, users must enter the location using the format required by the chosen type. You can choose from the three options highlighted in the image and described below:



1)	map_address allows users to enter an address as a single string. For example, 3307 Hillview Avenue Palo Alto, CA 94304 USA .
2)	map_address_detail allows users to enter address information in predefined fields for street, district, city, province, state, and country. Note that the district, province, and country fields are required.
3)	map_coordinate allows users to enter a latitude and longitude in designated fields and specify a Coordinate Reference System (CRS) to use. The add-on includes a default CRS, but you can also add your own. See Adding a Coordinate Reference System (CRS) for more details about adding a CRS.

The following steps show how to complete this task:

1. From the main menu bar, open the **Data Models** area and select the desired model.
2. In the **Navigation** pane, open *Configuration > Included data models* and select the + icon.



3. As shown above, select the **Packaged in module** option and in the **Model properties** group, choose **ebx-addon-common** for the **Module** name and select **/WEB-INF/ebx/schema/map-type.xsd** for the **Path in module** field. You can save and close the record.
4. Use the following steps to create a `map` type field:
 - Create a new field in your model.
 - Enter required and optional information.
 - For the **Kind of element**, select **Group**.
 - Select **Reuse an existing type**.
 - Select **Included data models** as the *Data type* and choose the desired map type from the drop-down menu. See the beginning of this section for information on each type.

5. Save and publish your data model.

The next step is to link the field you just created with a map widget. See the next section for details.

Configuring the map widget

You configure a map widget component to link a map widget to a data model field. The configuration allows you to specify display options and any required additional parameters. To configure a map widget:

1. Access the **Administration** area from the main menu bar and navigate to *TIBCO EBX® GO Add-on > Configuration > Widget Management > Widget Component*.
2. Create a new record and supply information for the required fields. The following image and table highlight some of the options.

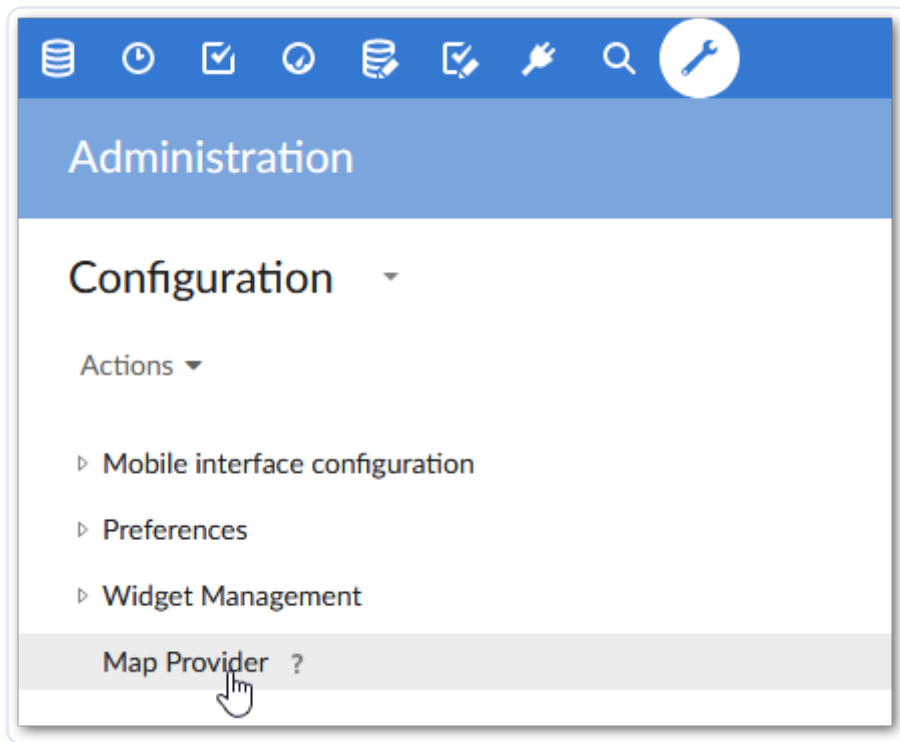

(1)	Set user permissions for this map.

API tokens from map providers

By default, map widgets display maps using OpenStreetMap. You can use an additional provider such as Google and specify that maps for specific tables display using this provider. When adding a map provider you can supply required API tokens. You can access the options to add a provider and API key using the **Map Provider** table.



Adding a Coordinate Reference System (CRS)

When you use the **map\coordinate** option in a map setup, the values (fields) used for defining a map location include latitude, longitude, and CRS. Users can choose from any configured CRS. The add-on includes a default CRS, however you can add additional options for users.

To add a CRS:

1. In the main menu, select the **Administration** area and navigate to *Technical configuration > Map Configuration*.
2. Create a new record and provide:
 - A unique name.
 - The CRS definition, which must use PROJ.4 formatting.
3. After saving and closing, the CRS is available for users to select.

Installing the app

Users can install the EBX GO Add-on for iOS or EBX GO Add-on for Android mobile applications on their devices using the Google Play Store, or Apple App Store.

Note:

As iOS receives frequent updates and automatic updates cannot be deactivated, the utmost effort is put forth in testing and supporting the latest available versions.

The following table lists the currently supported environments:

COMPONENT	VERSION SUPPORTED
Client side	The app is currently supported on devices running the following operating systems: • Android version 5.0 or higher • iOS 10 or higher
Server side	The add-on is currently supported when using EBX® 6.0.0 and higher. Note that the mobile app automatically downloads and installs the correct app version to ensure compatibility with the configured server.

Note:

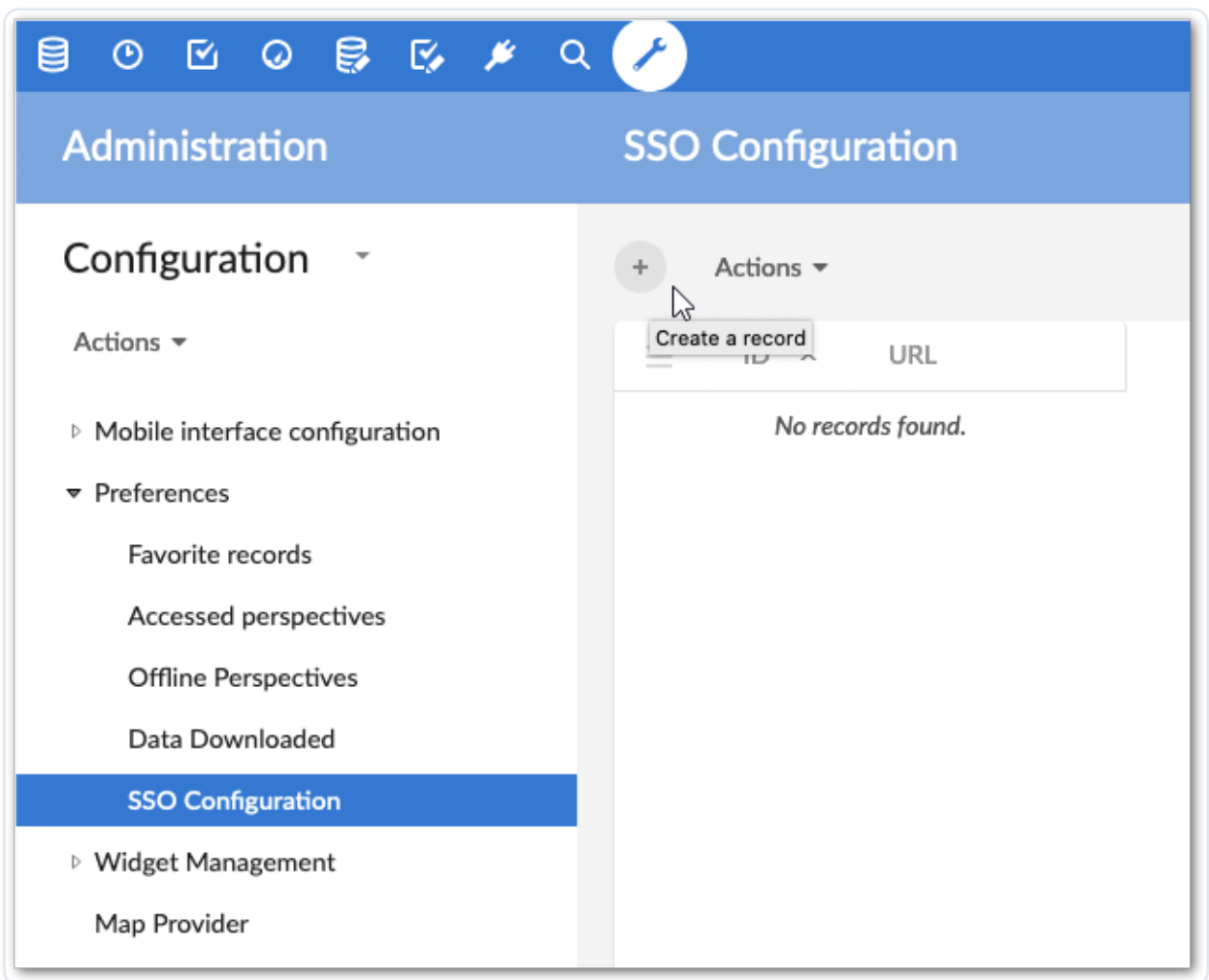
When installing the app on an Android device, the Android System WebView app (at least version 59.0.3071.125) must also be installed.

Configuring Single Sign-On

If your organization uses Single Sign-On authentication (SSO), you can allow users of the mobile app to log in with their SSO credentials. Note that this feature only supports using Security Assertion Markup Language (SAML) version 2.0.

To configure the add-on to work with SSO:

1. From the **Administration** panel, select *TIBCO EBX® GO Add-on > Configuration*.
2. Navigate to *Preferences > SSO Configuration* and create a new record.



3. In the **URL** field, provide the URL required to start the SSO session. Note that on successful verification, your identity provider (IDP) must redirect the user's browser to the following endpoint where EBX® is running: **http(s)://<host>:<port>/ebx-addon-moda/api/service/v1/createToken**.

After successfully completing the above steps, users will see the **Log in with SSO** option after connecting to the EBX® server.

Reference overview

The sections below describe the individual properties for the EBX GO Add-on. All options described below are located under *Administration > TIBCO EBX® GO Add-on > Configuration*.

Mobile interface configuration

The **Mobile interface configuration** domain contains the **Colors and themes** table.

Colors and themes

The **Colors and themes** table allows you to customize the look and feel of the mobile app. When viewing the app, the following properties override color settings set at the perspective level:

PROPERTY	DEFINITION
Override color of TIBCO EBX® GO Add-on perspective	Determines whether color and theme settings come from the configured perspective, or are overridden and specified below.
Primary color	Specifies the primary color displayed in the app. For example, this color will be used for logos representing tables.
Secondary color	Specifies the secondary color displayed in the app. This color will apply to icons such as the favorites icon.
Header background color	Specifies the header background color.
Header font color	Specifies the font color used in the header.
Default font	Specifies the default font used. You can choose from the device's native font, or the EBX® font.

Preferences

The **Preferences** domain uses the **Favorite records** table to store records starred by users.

Favorite records

The **Favorite records** table keeps track of records that users bookmark with the favorites feature in the app.

PROPERTY	DEFINITION
id	This is an auto-incremented value used to uniquely identify the record.
user	The user that starred the record.
Record	The record saved as a favorite.

Accessed perspective

The **Accessed perspective** table contains the following three properties that allow you to associate perspectives and user login:

PROPERTY	DEFINITION
Login	The user login linked with a perspective.
Accessed perspective	The last accessed perspective that the user logged in to the mobile app.
Favorite	The user can choose the perspective as favorite from the app.

- The mobile app does not currently support applying sort to fuzzy or error search results.
- Only the following data types are supported for filtering: HTML, string, text, email, XML, and foreign key.
- For associations, exact search and advanced search are supported. For the simple tabular view, exact search, validation search and advanced search are supported.
- For history, exact search and advanced search are supported.
- In the validation search results for a DAM field, the number of errors/warnings cannot be displayed for each DAM field.
- Incorrect results display when searching on the hierarchical view and a dimension is defined using a recursive foreign key.

- It is not currently possible to display the label of a foreign key field in the **Advanced Search** page although it is defined in EBX®.

Notifications and workflows

The following limitations apply to app notifications and workflows:

- Native notifications only work when the application is running in background mode.
- In the app you can only use workflow tasks for tables and records, not those for data sets and data spaces.
- Special workflow configurations such as **Enable confirmation request**, **Comment required**, **Reminder** and **Hidden in graph view** are not currently available.

TIBCO EBX® Digital Asset Manager Add-on integration

The following limitations apply to features when using EBX® Digital Asset Manager Add-on functionality:

- Only png, jpg, jpeg, bmp, gif, and PDF files can be previewed.
- Display of asset thumbnails in a custom tabular view is limited to a single value mediaType field located first in the record.
- It is not currently possible to display thumbnails in a custom hierarchical view.
- Thumbnails for gif images cannot be displayed. GIF images display as their actual size.
- If a group contains a DAM field and a maximum number of values is set for the field in the data model, assets cannot be viewed, attached, or detached.
- In iOS, you can only upload the following images types: PNG, JPEG, JPG, BMP, and GIF.
- The app may crash if a large file is uploaded (over 20 Mb).
- Using a Digital Asset Manager Drive that accesses an externally managed storage location to edit or add digital assets is not supported.

TIBCO EBX® Information Search Add-on integration

The following limitations apply to features when using EBX® Information Search Add-on capabilities:

- In the hierarchical and tabular views detailed results display as the global search default view.
- Keywords used in EBX® searches are not synchronized with the app.

General limitations

This release contains the following general limitations:

- The comparison feature in the mobile app only works with EBX® 5.9.0 Fix A or later. This also applies to workflows launched from EBX® prior to version 5.9.0 Fix A.
- The EBX GO mobile app on Android cannot connect using the HTTPS protocol when deploying TIBCO EBX® on WebLogic.

- Special workflow configurations such as **Enable confirmation request**, **Comment required**, **Reminder** and **Hidden in graph view** are not currently available.

TIBCO EBX® Digital Asset Manager Add-on integration

The following limitations apply to features when using EBX® Digital Asset Manager Add-on functionality:

TIBCO EBX® Information Search Add-on integration

- In the hierarchical and tabular views detailed results display as the global search default view.
- Keywords used in EBX® searches are not synchronized with the app.

General limitations

This release contains the following general limitations:

- The comparison feature in the mobile app only works with EBX® 5.9.0 Fix A or later. This also applies to workflows launched from EBX® prior to version 5.9.0 Fix A.
- The EBX GO mobile app on Android cannot connect using the HTTPS protocol when deploying TIBCO EBX® on WebLogic.
